



Fish Camp to Implement New Transportation Options

Since 1954, Texas A&M Fish Camp has welcomed incoming freshmen into the Aggie Family. We are excited to continue the work of sharing our love for Aggieland and being an “Aggie’s first tradition.” In order to continue to meet the ever-changing needs of our participants, we would like to announce we are implementing a new transportation opportunity for participants for Fish Camp 2024.

Fish Camp is held annually at Lakeview Methodist Conference Center near Palestine, TX with participants historically being transported from College Station on charter buses. After much planning and forecasting future trends for the Fish Camp program, it was determined that having charter buses as the sole transportation option from College Station was no longer serving participants in the best way.

For Fish Camp 2024, participants will have the opportunity to select between the following three transportation options for camp during the registration process which will open on Tuesday, April 16 at 12:00 pm (CST):

- Ride a bus from College Station. There will be limited spaces for bus transportation and will be available on a first come, first served basis, with a \$50 fee associated with this option.
- Drive themselves to Lakeview Methodist Conference Center or carpool with other participants attending the same session. There will be limited parking spaces available on a first come, first served basis with a \$15 fee associated with this option.
- Get dropped off at Lakeview Methodist Conference Center the day of their session and picked up on the last day of their session at specific times. This option does not have an additional fee.

Increasing accessibility is a high priority for the Fish Camp program and was at the heart of this decision. We want to provide as many opportunities as possible for participants to get to camp the way that works best for them.

As always, we will welcome the Class of 2028 with a “Howdy!” and all the excitement we can muster when they arrive. We are excited for this year and the opportunities this change will have for greater accessibility for participants. We look forward to another great year of Fish Camp!
